IT IS SUCH A WONDERFUL FEELING to finally be able to share this labour of love to music aficionados such as yourself, dear listener. Recording this album took its time and, at times, it seemed like all kinds of misfortunes (a global pandemic being just one of them) would make it impossible to get everything ready. It's been quite a task, to put it mildly.

This album started with a simple idea. We had been playing as a live act for a while and *Mikko* and I had a couple of new songs. We thought: let's just record them and see where that leads us! So we did. One of them sounded a bit like 90's *Pink Floyd*, another like early 80's *Genesis*... It became clear relatively early on that this was going to be a prog album. An album that was taking its influences from the classic bands of the genre: the aforementioned Pink Floyd, Genesis, (Finnish prog legends) *Wigwam*, *Procol Harum*, Yes and so on. While prog fans may recognise which song is "The Pink Floyd Song" or the "King Crimson Song" this is not meant to be a tribute album by any means. These are all original compositions after all. But it is, in a way, a humble, collective nod of the head from all of us in the band to all those fantastic pioneering prog groups that opened up our musical worlds to new levels of imagination.

While bad luck delayed the completion of this album, the delay was not without its silver lining. Fairly late in the process, while having roughly 80% of the material recorded and partially mixed, a moment of wonderful serendipity occurred. I had met *Durga McBroom*, famously a member of the Pink Floyd touring band in the 80's and 90's, when we performed together at a Pink Floyd tribute concert in 2015. We kept in touch through social media and, in the winter of 2022 while the whole of Europe seemed to be in pandemic-related lockdown, I noticed that Durga was doing sessions while waiting for live venues to open their doors. I sent her a message asking if she'd be interested in collaborating on a couple of songs. You can imagine how happy I was when she agreed to sing on the album. This was, after all, someone who had been a part of one of my favourite bands of all time. We were already very exited with having a major guest on the album when, again via serendipitous means, another opportunity opened. The band Wigwam had been an important inspiration for all of us in 5th Season and, being an experienced player in the Finnish rock scene, Mikko had been touring with *Jukka Gustavson*, the keyboard virtuoso, composer and one of the founding members of Wigwam. We played one of the songs to Jukka, he thought it was great, and suddenly we were booking him to play a session with us.

And so, after being almost crushed by the weight of unfortunate circumstances, this album now has significant artistic input by members of two of our favourite bands of all time. That alone is worth celebrating but there's also the labour of love element of the music itself. We set high standards for ourselves when we decided to make an album in the style of classic 70's prog-rock. Whether we were successful is, of course, up to the audience but, personally at least, the making of this album in and of itself was worth the experience. This is just the kind of music that I want to make. And that is a huge privilege.
