

ATSE TEWODROS PROJECT is a musical ensemble coordinated by writer and performer Gabriella Ghermandi developing musical expressions between Ethiopian and Italian musicians.

MAQEDA – the Ethiopian name of the Queen of Sheba– is a project dedicated to historical and mythological female figures of Ethiopia and to the rituals of Ethiopian ethnic groups that have women at their center.

In this new album, Atse Tewodros Project broadens its scope further through the collaboration of special guests: musicians from Senegal, Italian singers, a beatboxer, and a body music performer.

Saba, you went on a journey




Heroine, you queen of Ethiopia




## Lucy
